- 1. The Minutes of the Half Yearly General Meeting from 10 May 2016 were reviewed and confirmed, moved by Mr Gauslaa, seconded by Mr Brown & confirmed
- **2. Business arising from the 2016 Half Yearly General Meeting,** there was no business arising from the 2016 meeting.
- **3.** Review and approve the WCRA Budget for the 2017 / 2018 year moved by Mr Turner, seconded by Mr Bayliss & confirmed that the WCRA budget for 2017/2018 be approved based on a budgeted revenue of \$755,550 & a Net Surplus of \$44,141
- **4.** Review and approve the Membership Fee Structure for the 2017 / 2018, moved by Mr Wilson, seconded by Mr Falanga and confirmed that the Membership Fee structure (invoicing 198 Members) be approved at a value of \$405,822 (plus GST)

5. **General Business**

- i. National Waste & Recycling Industry Council (NWRIC)
 - Mr Khoury confirmed the decision of the Executive to accept an invitation for WCRA to be the Affiliate of NWRIC in NSW & the ACT. Members were also

advised that WCRA will be represented by Mr Wilson & Mr Khoury with Mark Taylor, Veolia & Jason Stewart, SUEZ ACT as the alternate representatives.

ii. TWUSUPER

 Mr Khoury invited Mr Mohan-Ram to detail the importance of our relationship in the delivery of proper superannuation education to Employers & Workers across the WCRA Membership. Mr Mohan-Ram thanked WCRA for their support of TWUSUPER, re-enforced the importance of proper superannuation planning and congratulated the Members on having such a well-structured & organized industry association.

iii. Industry Update 15 June 2017

 Mr Khoury advised of the importance of attending this WCRA event and supporting WCRA to promote positive Chain of Responsibility outcomes through better RMS & EPA enforcement of fringe operators, who transport waste over a long distance, using unsuitable & poorly maintained equipment. The Members unanimously agreed, that these low barriers to entry and poor enforcement were creating long term concerns for the waste industry
