■ **Garden vegetation**

■ **Paper and cardboard**

■ **Plastic**

■ **Glass bottles and jars**

■ **Textiles** e.g. clothing, carpets etc.

■ **Tyres**

■ **Metals**

Where possible each workshop will include a site tour and/or a presentation on resource recovery, recycling, waste management, etc.
